Dear Heidelberg Resident,

Now that Jim Filipek has retired, we are excited to inform you that the city of Heidelberg welcomes Corey Block as its new Building Inspector. Corey comes to us with many years of experience and has a well of information to help you with your building needs. He also services the cities of Cleveland, Le Center and Montgomery.

The City of Heidelberg has adopted the MN State Building Code. With this change, permits will be required for most building/ remodeling projects. So please contact City Council to avoid any potential penalties. All permits must continue to be brought before the City Council for prior approval. To avoid any penalties, all plans must also include the involvement of the city Building Inspector before the start of any project. There are certain situations that may arise calling for more urgent action. An example being the need to replace a water heater. In those instances, you would go ahead and replace the water heater, then apply for the permit and call Corey for an inspection.

For permits, fee schedules and other information pertaining to building and remodeling, please check out the city inspector's website at cblockinspections.com. There you will find the tab titled Heidelberg which holds the necessary forms and information needed for future projects. If you do not have access to the internet, permits and fee schedules will also be available at city hall.

The City of Heidelberg is working to bring its website up to speed in order to bring you current information. It is updated regularly to include past monthly meeting minutes, current monthly meeting agendas, changes happening within its government, as well as community information. New and amended ordinances will also be posted as soon as they become available. So, don't forget to check it out from time to time at cityofheidelbergmn.com.
